

Rating: 5 of 5 Stars! Photos: 8 Videos: - This is an older review, but I recently purchased this box for a few reasons. First, I live in a small apartment and am not home a lot. Having a home server at the office for easy access is vital. Second, I was using a different NAS until a few months ago, and while the old one worked fine, the older model is not very reliable. The Home Server is solid, fast, has great features and works well with Windows. Third, the older NAS was not supported by Windows Home Server 2011 and I was unable to set up some of the features the new box has. With that in mind, I decided to upgrade to the new Home Server. The first thing I noticed was that the new server is smaller than the older one, which is to be expected since it's a much more powerful machine. The second thing I noticed is that the power cable doesn't fit inside the server. The only way to supply power to the server is by using an external power supply. The only power supply the server came with is a 120 V AC power supply. Once the server is plugged in, you'll notice a beep or a click. That's when the server is ready for configuration. The home server software is very intuitive. You'll be able to easily configure and use all the features with minimal training. One feature I was hoping to use more with the new server is Windows Home Server's link building function. The old server had a Links button at the top of the home server interface. With the new server, you can use the web page from the browser, but in order for the links to build, you have to physically be on the same network as the server. It's a very minor annoyance, but I'm pretty sure it's designed this way to allow you to host the site from a browser on a laptop or desktop computer. If I can give this service a thumbs up, I will.
